

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS, PRESCRIBING RATES AND CHARGES FOR LOCAL EXCHANGE TELEPHONE SERVICE FURNISHED BY FORT BEND TELEPHONE COMPANY.

19 WHEREAS, Fort Bend Telephone Company has appeared before the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Beasley, Texas, and has shown that the rates and charges for local exchange telephone service heretofore prescribed have proved insufficient to afford said Company a fair return on the fair value of its property devoted to furnishing local exchange telephone service in the Beasley telephone exchange, and

WHEREAS, the following schedule of rates will not produce for said Company more than a fair return on the fair value of its said property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1: Fort Bend Telephone Company shall place in effect the following schedule of rates on its first billing date after final passage of this ordinance:

<u>Class of Service</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>
Business telephone one party flat rate	\$13.50
Residence telephone one party flat rate	8.25
Business telephone two party flat rate	11.50
Residence telephone two party flat rate	7.75
Coin Telephones	.10
Business extensions	2.00
Residence extensions	1.50

Section 2: Nothing in this ordinance contained shall be construed now or hereafter as limiting or modifying, in any manner, the right and power of the town under the law to regulate the rates and charges of Fort Bend Telephone Company.

Section 3: The Fort Bend Telephone Company agrees to furnish the central office equipment for a fire alarm system for the Town of Beasley for a period of 5 years. This equipment is to be furnished without cost to the Town upon the condition that the Fort Bend Telephone Company will have no liability of any kind as a result of the failure of the system to operate. The alarm service will be furnished to 10 firemen designated by the Town for as long as the firemen named live within the City limits of Beasley and have (1) one party service.
