AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY FOR THE YEAR 1976

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of General Obligation Bonds Series 1975 of the Town of Beasley, for the year nineteen hundred and seventy six, upon all property, real, business and mixed, within the corporate limits of said Town subject to taxation, a tax of twenty five cents (.25) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property, said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purposes here set forth;

(1) For the maintenance and support of the General Government (water and sewer fund), Twenty five cents (.25) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property.

Section 2. There is hereby levied and there shall be collected from every person, firm, association, or corporation pursuing any occupation taxed by the General Laws of the State of Texas and subject to a city occupation tax under the laws of this state, an annual occupation tax equal in each instance to one-half of the State occupation tax, which said, taxes shall be paid annually in advance except where otherwise provided by the State Laws, in which event the same may be paid as is provided by the State Law.

Section 3. All monies collected under this ordinance for the specific items therein named, be and the same are hereby appropriated and set apart for the specific purpose indicated in each item and that the Assessor and Collector of Taxes, the Town Treasurer and the Town Secretary shall keep these accounts so as to readily and distinctly show the amount collected, the amounts expended and the amount on hand at any time, belonging to such funds, it is hereby made the duty of the Tax Assessor and Collector of Taxes and every person collecting money for the Town of Beasley, to deliver to the Town Treasurer and the Town Secretary at the time of depositing any monies, a statement showing to what fund such deposit should be made and from what source received. All receipts for the Town not specifically apportioned by this Ordinance are hereby made payable to the Water and Sewer Fund of the Town.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
