ORDINANCE APPOINTING CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT IN BEASLEY, TEXAS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE CITY SECRETARY OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, TO HOLD THE OFFICE OF CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT IN BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, WITH THE TERM OF CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT TO RUN CONCURRENTLY WITH THE TERM OF CITY SECRETARY; ESTABLISHING THE DUTIES OF THE CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

35 WHEREAS, Article 1200 of V.A.C.S. provides that a city may, by ordinance, appoint its City Secretary to hold the office of Clerk of the Municipal Court, and for such term of office as Clerk of the Municipal Court to run concurrently with the term of office for City Secretary, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY:

Section 1. Pursuant to Article 1200, V.A.C.S., the Secretary for the City of Beasley, Texas, will hereinafter also hold the office of Clerk of the Municipal Court in Beasley, Fort Bend County, Texas.

Section 2. The term of office for such clerk of the Municipal Court shall henceforth run concurrently with the term of office of City Secretary.

Section 3. The Clerk of the Municipal Court shall have all such rights, duties, and powers as are hereby provided by law or as such law may be hereinafter amended.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective as the date of execution and approval hereof.

Section 2. The term of office for such clerk of the Municipal Court shall henceforth run concurrently with the term of office of City Secretary.


Section 3. The Clerk of the Municipal Court shall have all such rights, duties, and powers as are hereby provided by law or as such law may be hereinafter amended.


