

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF MUNICIPAL JUDGE OF BEASLEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS OF THE JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT IN THE TOWN OF BEASLEY; ESTABLISHING THE LENGTH OF TERM FOR SUCH OFFICE; ESTABLISHING THE DUTIES OF MUNICIPAL JUDGE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby created the office of Municipal Judge for the Town of Beasley, Fort Bend County, Texas.

Section 2. That the Board of Aldermen shall appoint an individual as Judge of the Municipal Court, such person to hold office for the length of time corresponding to the time remaining in the incumbent Mayor's term of office.

Section 3. That the term of office for such Judge of the Municipal Court will be that which is provided by statute.

Section 4. That the Judge of the Municipal Court must qualify as such in the manner provided by statute.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
