

ORDINANCE NO. 43


AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING THE IMPOSITION OF
THE 1% CITY SALES TAX ON RESIDENTIAL USE
OF GAS AND ELECTRICITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Town of Beasley elects to
continue the imposition of the 1% City Sales Tax on the
residential use of gas and electricity.

Section 2. That the Town of Beasley reserves
the right to amend this ordinance and establish an exemption
for the residential use of gas and electricity at such future
date as the Town of Beasley may deem necessary.


