Call to Order: Mayor Kenneth Reid called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Approve minutes from October 16, 2018 meeting: Mr. Harris made the motion to accept the minutes as written and Mr. Lindemann seconded. Motion carried.

Mayor Announcements: The citizen who ran into the Cemetery Square fence was not a designated driver on the insurance; therefore the insurance company has denied payment. Council agreed City should pursue since the cost of repairing the fence is \$1,450.00. Mayor Reid will contact attorney for advice.

Bonnie Morley of Terramore Ltd. has notified City that she will be closing on the fourteen plus acres located inside the city limits on December 14, 2018. The buyer is Kashef Saleem.

There will be no council meeting in December.
