AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 4, 1997, TO HAVE THE CITY'S VOTERS DECIDE WHETHER TO APPROVE AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SALES TAX


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

The City Council hereby calls for a special election for November 4, 1997, to be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code and any other applicable law, for the city's voters to vote whether:


1. to adopt a sales and use tax at the rate of one-half of one-percent for promotion and development of new and expanded business enterprises; and/or
2. to adopt a sales and use tax at the rate of one-half of one-percent to be used for the promotion and development of facilities to furnish water to the general public; sewage and solid waste disposal facilities; new or expanded business enterprises, parks and any other purpose authorized by The Development Corporation Act of 1979, Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann. Art. 5190.6, Section 4B as amended, including but not limited to land, buildings, equipment, facilities, and improvements required or suited for amateur sports (including children's sports); athletic, entertainment, tourist, convention, and public park facilities, including ball parks, learning centers, parks, open space improvements, including land, buildings, museum exhibition facilities and related

stores, concessions, and parking and transportation facilities; and any other projects related thereto; and maintenance and operating costs associated with all of the above projects.
