

ORDINANCE NO. 128

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING AUTHORITY TO REMOVE AND REPLACE DRIVE-WAY CULVERTS IN THE CITY AT LANDOWNERS' EXPENSE.

WHEREAS, Tex. Trans. Code Ann. §311.002 (Vernon 1999) authorizes Type A General-Law Municipalities such as the City of Beasley, Texas, to construct, regulate, or maintain culverts in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the Fort Bend County, Texas Engineering Department recommends drainage plans calculated to alleviate actual or potential drainage problems within the City of Beasley, Texas; and

WHEREAS, those plans sometimes include or recommend removal or replacement of existing drive-way culverts with larger or more adequate culverts, at the landowner's expense;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. To relieve actual or potential drainage problems in the City of Beasley, Texas, the City Council may have existing drive-way culverts removed and replaced with larger or more adequate culverts, and in such event the landowner across whose property the drive-way culvert lies shall bear all costs of the removal and replacement.

Section 2. The City of Beasley, Texas, shall implement this ordinance by having Fort Bend County, Texas, or any other qualified entity to replace and install such drive-way culverts.
