

ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY FOR THE 1999/2000 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Beasley, and to provide an Interest and Sinking Fund for the 1999/2000 fiscal year, upon all property, real, personal and mixed, within the corporate limits of said City subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.22968 on each \$100.00 valuation of property, said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purposes here set forth:

- a. For the maintenance and support of the general government (General Fund): \$0.0879101 on each \$100.00 valuation of property;
- b. For the interest and sinking fund: \$0.0847108 on each \$100.00 valuation of property; and
- c. For the maintenance and support of the water and sewer system (Water and Sewer Fund) \$0.0570591 on each \$100.00 valuation of property.


Section 2. That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 1999 and if not paid on or before February 1, 2000 shall immediately become delinquent.

Section 3. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the City Assessor and Collector of the City of Beasley is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Beasley shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the interest and penalty collected from such delinquent taxes shall be apportioned to the general fund of the City of Beasley. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate as prescribed by state law.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.


