ORDINANCE NO. 2002-10



AN ORDINANCE INCREASING MONTHLY SEWER SERVICE RATES FOR OVER 2,000 GALLONS OF WATER CONSUMED; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **BEASLEY, TEXAS:**

Section 1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary previously enacted by the City Council of Beasley, Texas, the rates for sewer service are hereby increased as follows:

Rates for sewer service are based on water consumed as registered on each customer's meter. The following rates per month shall be the rates charged for Sanitary Sewer Service to water consumer's within the corporate limits of the City of Beasley:

First 2,000 gallons

\$7.50 Minimum

All over 2,000 gallons

\$1.75 per 1,000 gallons

\$0.175 per 100 gallons or fraction thereof

For all service in excess of fifteen (15) days in each calendar month, a full monthly minimum charge plus usage shall apply. For fifteen (15) days or less in each calendar month a charge of fifty (50) percent of the minimum will be charged or \$7.50.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective October 01, 2002, after its passage and approval.
