

CONSTRUCTION SPEED ZONE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS DURING CONSTRUCTION ALONG A PORTION OF US 59 WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has made it known to the City of Beasley that operations will begin in the near future to upgrade US 59; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of safety, it is desirable to maintain a construction speed zone during the construction period; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BEASLEY that a construction speed zone be established along the named highways or parts thereof described as follows:

Along US 59 main lanes from Engineer's Station 355+00 (approximately 5,800 feet south of Isleib Road) to the north city limits of the City of Beasley (approximately 3,200 feet north of Isleib Road), a distance of approximately 1.70 miles, 55 MPH.

Necessary signs for posting the speed zones will be furnished, installed, and maintained by the direction of the Texas Department of Transportation engineer in charge of the project.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a class C misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not to exceed Four Hundred Dollars (\$400).

This ordinance shall be in effect only during the period of construction, and completion of this project shall automatically cancel the speed zones.
