



ORDINANCE NO. 2007-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2003-2 RELATING TO THE SALE OF BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR, HOURS OF CONSUMPTION, SALES NEAR SCHOOL, CHURCH OR HOSPITAL AND LOCATIONS IN CITY OF BEASLEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to impose restrictions on the operation of the "Selling of Beer, Wine and Liquor" after having been advised of numerous studies and reports by other cities that demonstrate that the presence of businesses have certain 'secondary effects' on adjoining property values, an increase in crime, noise, traffic, litter and in health risks and pressures for other businesses to move elsewhere and;

Section 1. MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR

1. Prohibit the sale of beer, wine and liquor in a residential area;
2. Regulate the sale of beer, wine and liquor and prescribe the hours it may be sold According to Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission rules. No beer, wine or liquor may be sold except retailers selling beer, wine or liquor for off-premises (Package Stores, Convenience Stores, Truck Stops, Super Markets, etc);
3. Map enclosure to show city limits.

Section 2. "STANDARD HOURS AREA" MEANING AN AREA WHICH IS NOT AN EXTENDED HOURS AREA

In a standard hours area, a person commits an offense if he consumes or possesses with intent to consume an alcoholic beverage in a public place at any time on Sunday between 1:15 A.M. and 12:00 NOON or on any other day between 12:15 A.M. and 7:00 A.M.

Section 3. SALES NEAR SCHOOL, CHURCH OR HOSPITAL

1. Church means a place used primarily for religious worship on a regular basis.
2. 500 feet from a church, public or private school, public hospital or daycare.

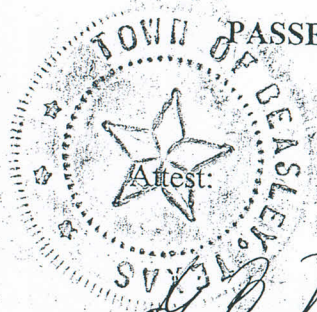
Section 4. CHURCH AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION


A church and non-profit organization will come before Council for approval on special permits.


Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE
