

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 49, SECTION 2, PROHIBITING THE SALE OF NEW FIREWORKS WITHIN TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (2,500) FEET OF BEASLEY CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:


**Section 2.** GENERAL PROHIBITION AGAINST MANUFACTURE, SALE, DISCHARGE, TRANSPORTATION, POSSESSION, ETC.


Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer for sale, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire, or have in his possession any fireworks of any description within 2,500 feet of the city limits. This provision is prospective and shall not apply to any fireworks sold prior on the effective date of this ordinance. Existing fireworks will be grandfathered.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
