ORDINANCE NO. 2010-2

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING RATES FOR MONTHLY WATER CONSUMPTON FOR FIRST 2,000 GALLONS AND OVER OF WATER CONSUMED BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-10; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2005-10 concerning the waterworks system of the City of Beasley, as set out above, and as passed and approved heretofore on the 18th day of October 2005, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Rates for water are based on water consumed as registered on each customer's meter. The following rates per month shall be the rates charged for water furnished to water consumers within the corporate limits of the City of Beasley:

First 2,000 gallons

\$12.50 Minimum

All over 2,000 gallons

\$ 2.25 per 1,000 gallons

For all service in excess of fifteen (15) days in each calendar month, a full monthly minimum charge plus usage shall apply. For fifteen (15) days or less in each calendar month, a charge of fifty (50) percent of the minimum will be charged or \$12.50.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective October 01, 2010 after its passage and approval.
