AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY AND PROVIDING FOR THE INTEREST AND SINKING FUND FOR THE YEAR 1980 AND APPURTIONING EACH LEVY FOR THE SPECIFIED PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there be levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the numberial government for the Town of Beasley and to provide interest and sinking fund for the year 1980 upon all property real, personal, and mixed within the corporate city limits of the Town of Feasley subject to taxation a tax of \$.13 personal and one can be called do lar valuation of property and tax being so levied and apportioned to the specified purpose here set forth:

- (1) For the maintenance and support of the general government (general find -0-) on each \$100 valuation on the same of and

 (2) For the interest and sinking fund, \$.13 /c

All monies collected under this ordinance for the specific items therein haned, be, and there are bareby, and copriated and set apart for the specific frames induced and that the assessor and collector of these, and the Town Secretary/ show the amount collected, the amount expended, and distinctly on hand at any time, belonging to the interest and sinking fund. It is hereby made the duty of the tax assessor-collector for at the time of depositing any monies a state ant sho ing time amount of money deposited to the interest and sinking fund.
