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ORDINANCE NO. 5/

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A BROPOSED STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Beasley, after due investigation and consideration, has determined the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of parts of the proposed public Cross-alleys Ef.

That all that part of Block Eight (8), located between 7th and 8th Streets on Avenue C in the Town of Beasley which was previously dedicated to the Town of Beasley as two 20 foot by 110 foot alleys, being further described as located between Lots 1 and 2, and Lot 3, bordering on 8th Street and Lots 6 and 7 and Lot 8 on 7th Street, all abutting land of which is owned by Theodor Mattheaus, and indicated by the words "to be vacated" on the drawings hereto attached, which drawings for greater certainty are hereby made a part of this Release, and marked, "Exhibit "A" and "B" and more specifically described as follows:

A 20 foot by 110 foot alley being out of Block 8 of the Town of Beasley, Fort Bend County, Texas, and more particularly described by field note description attached hereto as "Exhibit C" and made a part hereof; and

A 20 foot by 110 foot alley being out of Block 8 of the Town of Beasley, Fort Bend County, Texas, and more particularly described by field note description attached hereto as "Exhibit D" and made a part hereof,

be, and the same is no longer required for public use and has in fact been abandoned by the City and the public interest will be served by the vacation of said proposed street.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The fee to the land in the above described cross alleys as shown in Exhibits "A" and "C" and "B" and "D" is hereby

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released and will revert to the adjacent owner, Theodor Mattheaus, as provided by law, save and except that easements are reserved for any and all existing utilities. Within 30 days from the passage of this Ordinance, the Clerk of the Board of Aldermen shall file, or cause to be filed, in the office of the recorder of Deeds of Fort Bend County, Texas, a certified copy of this Ordinance; said costs to be paid by the Petitioner.




