ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING A PRIOR ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED HERETOFORE ON THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH, 1971, AND BEING ORDINANCE NO. 4; AND PROVIDING FOR THE LENGTH OF TERM FOR THE POSITION OF MARSHALL OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 4, passed and approved heretofore on the 16th day of March, 1971, be and is hereby expressly repealed.

Section 2. That the length of term for the position of Marshall of the Town of Beasley shall be fixed in the manner provided by statute.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

NOTICE


