

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY AND PROVIDING FOR THE INTEREST AND SINKING FUND FOR THE YEAR 1981 AND APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR THE SPECIFIED PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there be levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government for the Town of Beasley and to provide interest and sinking fund for the year 1981 upon all property real, personal, and mixed within the corporate city limits of the Town of Beasley subject to taxation a tax of \$ .15 on each one hundred dollar valuation of property and tax being so levied and apportioned to the specified purpose here set forth:

- (1) For the maintenance and support of the general government (general fund - 0 -) on each \$100 valuation on property, and
- (2) For the interest and sinking fund \$ .15 on each \$100 valuation of property for the 1975 series obligation bonds.

Section 2. All monies collected under this ordinance for the specific items therein named, be, and the same are hereby, appropriated and set apart for the specific purpose inducted and that the assessor and collector of taxes, and the Town Secretary/Treasurer shall keep this account so as to readily and distinctly show the amount collected, the amount expended, and the amount on hand at any time, belonging to the interest and sinking fund. It is hereby made the duty of the tax assessor-collector for the Town of Beasley, to deliver to the Town Secretary/Treasurer at the time of depositing any monies a statement showing the amount of money deposited to the interest and sinking fund.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
