

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF HOUSEHOLD TRASH AND GARBAGE, ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR THE SERVICE, PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION OF SAID FEE, PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN, OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Town of Beasley, Texas, in order to insure the prompt and orderly collection of household trash and garbage from various locations within the Town of Beasley, shall contract on an annual basis with such firm or firms acceptable to the Town to provide for the sanitary disposition of such household trash and garbage.

Section 2. That such contract shall be under the terms established by the Town to promote continued health and sanitation within said Town.

Section 3. That the Town shall assess a fee for the collection of such household trash and garbage to be paid by the owner of each registered sewer connection within the Town of Beasley, such fee becoming due and payable at the same time the owner's sewer bill becomes due and payable.

Section 4. That no individual, firm, corporation, partnership or other business entity shall be allowed to collect for disposal any household trash or garbage collected within the Town of Beasley, without the express prior written permission of the Town.

Section 5. That nothing contained herein shall limit or restrict any individual or business located within the Town of Beasley from hauling or disposing of its own household trash and garbage; however, payment to the Town for such collection service as set out herein above is mandatory by the owner of each registered sewer connection within the Town of Beasley, whether the owner makes use of said household trash and garbage collection service or not. The fee so assessed shall be ~~6.00~~ for residential service and ~~11.75~~ for commercial service payable per month as set out in Section 3 above.

Section 6. If any part of this Ordinance shall be found unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect unless and until changed by the Board of Aldermen, Town of Beasley.

Section 7. The provisions and requirements set out herein shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
