

ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO PARK ANY VEHICLE IN EXCESS OF TWO TONS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH ROADWAY SHOULDERS OF AVENUE E BETWEEN NORTH 3RD AND NORTH 8TH STREET; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:

(1) It shall herein be unlawful for any person to park any portion of any vehicle that is in excess of two tons in weight for the total vehicle on any portion of the North or the South roadway shoulders of Avenue E between North 3rd Street and North 8th Street.

(2) The term "person" shall include any individual, company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, association, or any other legal entity. The term "park" shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, for any length of time.

(3) Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$200.00.

(4) If any section, phrase, word, or clause herein is for any reason held to be void or invalid, such decision shall not affect or in any way invalidate the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

(5) That vehicles in excess of two tons are parking on the north and south roadway shoulders of Avenue E between North 3rd Street and North 8th Street of the Town of Beasley creating a dangerous and emergency situation. The importance of this

ordinance creates an emergency and imperative public necessity that any and all rules requiring customary readings of ordinances be suspended and the rules are hereby suspended and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
