**MINUTES

Call to Order: Mayor Kenneth Reid called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Roll Call: Council Members Jerri Lindemann, Carolyn Sabrsula and Al Becan were present. Douglas Harris and Yvonne Meyer were absent.

Approve minutes from September 17, 2019: Mr. Becan made the motion to accept the minutes as written and Mrs. Lindemann seconded. *Motion carried.*

Mayor Announcements: SUEZ began preparing the water tower for pressure washing on Thursday, October 10th.

City is finishing paperwork on Phase II of the Sanitary Sewer System grant for the south side and it will then go out for bids. Phase III will begin in March of 2020.

Communication from the public

OLD BUSINESS

A. Discuss and act on bringing City Hall restrooms up to ADA Standards

RCR Construction has submitted a proposal but details have not yet been finalized.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Ed Kegley to discuss speed limit signs

Mr. Kegley informed City that traffic speeds up to fifty, sixty to seventy on South Third and Fourth Streets. He is requesting "30 MPH-No Tolerance" signs be installed. City will turn in work order for signs to be placed at South Third and Fourth Streets on Avenues G and I.

Financial Report: Ms. Wanda Andel presented Council with a Financial Statement showing the First National Bank of E. Bernard accounts: General Fund with \$3,102.57 and the Water/Sewer Account with \$27,286.84 and The First National Bank of Bellville General Fund with \$99,737.90 and the Water/Sewer Account with \$105,735.04. Mrs. Lindemann made the motion to accept the report, pay the bills and Ms. Sabrsula seconded. *Motion seconded.*
