## Ordinance 2021 – 5

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREN TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS, FOR THE 2021 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY:

**SECTION 1.** That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Beasley, upon all property, real, personal and mixed, within the corporate limits of said City subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.379746 on each \$100.00 valuation of property, and said tax being so levied and apportioned to the specific purposes here set forth:

- 1. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THATN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. For the maintenance and support of the general government (General Find), \$0.286574 on each \$100.00 valuation of property;
  - 2. For the Debit Rate, \$0.093172 on each \$100.00 valuation of property

**SECTION 2.** That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 01, 2021 and if not paid on or before January 01, 2022 shall immediately become delinquent.

SECTION 3. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the City Assessor and Collector of the City of Beasley is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of suck taxes according to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Beasley shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the interest and penalty collected from such delinquent taxes shall be apportioned in the general fund of the city of Beasley. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate as prescribed by state law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
